


Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT) for 2nd graders

Between October 23 – November 10, 2023, our school will be administering the Cognitive Abilities Test (CogAT) to 2nd graders. This is a screening test that the Green Bay Area Public School District is administering to all students to give the school additional information on how best to serve your child. The CogAT provides a snapshot of your child's abilities in the areas of verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal functioning.

The nonverbal battery tests a student's reasoning abilities and does not require the student to use information gained from other experiences to solve problems. The CogAT takes approximately 55 minutes and is administered on a computer.

Participation is voluntary. Please contact Mrs.

Dolan if you do not wish to participate. We expect to receive the testing results in November 2023. At that time, a copy of your child's results will be shared with you. You can find information from the publisher of this assessment at www.cogat.com.
